Hello Neighbours,

We hope you have been well since our last communication about the Paintearth Wind Project in September. As the year comes to an end, our team at the Paintearth Wind Project LP would like to provide you with some quick updates on the Project.

We have had a successful construction season since breaking ground in September, and as of December 15th, construction activities have officially wrapped up for the year. This year, we finished setting up the laydown area, completed 95% of the road stripping, cleared all the turbine pads, constructed almost 50% of the new roads and upgraded almost half of the existing roads.

Construction activities will resume in March 2023 and be in full swing until the end of next year. In the spring, we will begin installing collector lines, constructing all the new roads, upgrading the existing roads, starting turbine excavations, and constructing the Lanes Lake Substation. There will continue to be a slight increase in traffic on the road as trucks of gravel are delivered to the site for the new roads.

As always, thank you for your ongoing cooperation, accommodation, and support for the Paintearth Wind Project. If there is any issue regarding the Project site over the winter, please reach out to me at any time.
