Dear Stakeholder,

We hope that you and your families are safe and healthy during this unprecedented time in our history. The COVID-19 pandemic has forced us all to prioritize our daily lives and to focus on what is most important to us all, our health.

Further to our letter from November 13, 2019, Paintearth Wind Project LP (PWLP) is pleased to provide the following update.

On January 22, 2020, the Paintearth Wind Project (PWP) received its Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approval. Thank you to everyone who provided feedback on the PWP along the way. We value our relationships with local communities and appreciate your continued interest in the PWP. The AUC approval is a very significant milestone and we are excited to continue the development of the PWP.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, PWLP has modified the Project schedule. Amongst many things, COVID-19 has had an impact on supply chain, financial markets, construction practices and communities. As such, PWLP will be submitting a request to the AESO for an extension to the project's in-service date (ISD) to work through the impacts of COVID-19. An updated schedule is shown below:
